The Lighting of the Advent Candle(s)

Leader We light this first candle to remember the prophets who announced the coming of

the Messiah

All Amen. Lord give us ears to hear the prophets' call and eyes to see the fulfilment of all

their hopes in Jesus Christ.

Confession & The Peace

Leader God so loved the world

that he gave his only Son Jesus Christ

to save us from our sins, to be our advocate in heaven, and to bring us to eternal life.

Let us confess our sins in penitence and faith, firmly resolved to keep God's commandments

and to live in love and peace with all.

All Almighty God, our heavenly Father,

we have sinned against you and against our neighbour in thought and word and deed, through negligence, through weakness, through our own deliberate fault.

We are truly sorry and repent of all our sins.

For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, who died for us, forgive us all that is past and grant that we may serve you in newness of life to the glory of your name.

The Word of God

A passage of Scripture is read, after which we say:

Reader This is the Word of the Lord.

All Thanks be to God.

A short talk may be shared

The Apostles' Creed is said

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead.
On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

3rd Sunday of Advent

God for whom we watch and wait, you sent John the Baptist to prepare the way of your Son: give us courage to speak the truth, to hunger for justice, and to suffer for the cause of right, with Jesus Christ our Lord.

4th Sunday of Advent

Eternal God, as Mary waited for the birth of your Son, so we wait for his coming in glory; bring us through the birth pangs of this present age to see, with her, our great salvation in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Leader As our risen Saviour taught us, so we pray:

All Our Father in heaven,

hallowed be your name,

your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

Forgive us our sins

as we forgive those who sin against us.

Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and for ever.

Thanksgiving

Leader Our Lord Jesus told us that whenever two or three meet in his name,

he would be with them.

Whether we are at home alone or with many others, the Lord is here amongst us as we gather in his name.

All His Spirit is with us.

Leader Lift up your hearts.

All We lift them to the Lord.

Leader Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All It is right to give thanks and praise.

Leader It is indeed right,

it is our duty and our joy, at all times and in all places to give you thanks and praise, holy Father, heavenly King, almighty and eternal God,

through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord.

All To you be praise and glory for ever.

Leader Through him you have sent upon us

your holy and life-giving Spirit,

and made us a people for your own possession.

Therefore, with angels and archangels, and with all the company of heaven,

we proclaim your great and glorious name,

for ever praising you and saying:

All Holy, holy, holy Lord,

God of power and might,

heaven and earth are full of your glory.

Leader On the same night that he was betrayed,

Leader Great is the mystery of faith

All Christ has died:

Christ will come again.

All Jesus, Lamb of God,

have mercy on us.

Jesus, bearer of our sins,

have mercy on us.

Jesus, redeemer of the world,

grant us peace.

Leader We look forward to the day that we will feast with Him in Heaven, and pray:

All We do not presume

to come to your table, merciful Lord, trusting in our own righteousness, but in your manifold and great mercies.

We are not worthy

so much as to gather up the crumbs under your table.

But you are the same Lord

whose nature is always to have mercy.

Grant us therefore, gracious Lord,

so to eat the flesh of your dear Son Jesus Christ

and to drink his blood,

that our sinful bodies may be made clean by his body and our souls washed through his most precious blood, and that we may evermore dwell in him, and he in us.

Amen.

may His Holy Spirit in us cause us to

see Christ more clearly

All Amen

Leader love him more dearly

All Amen

Leader follow him more nearly

All Amen. Lord Jesus, we watch and wait for your return.
