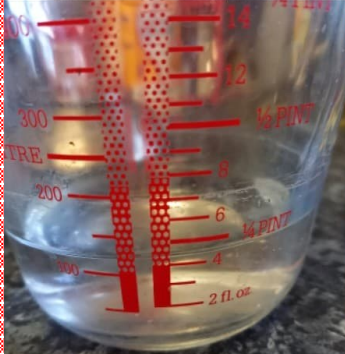


SALT DOUGH NATIVITY CRAFT

oven on lowest setting

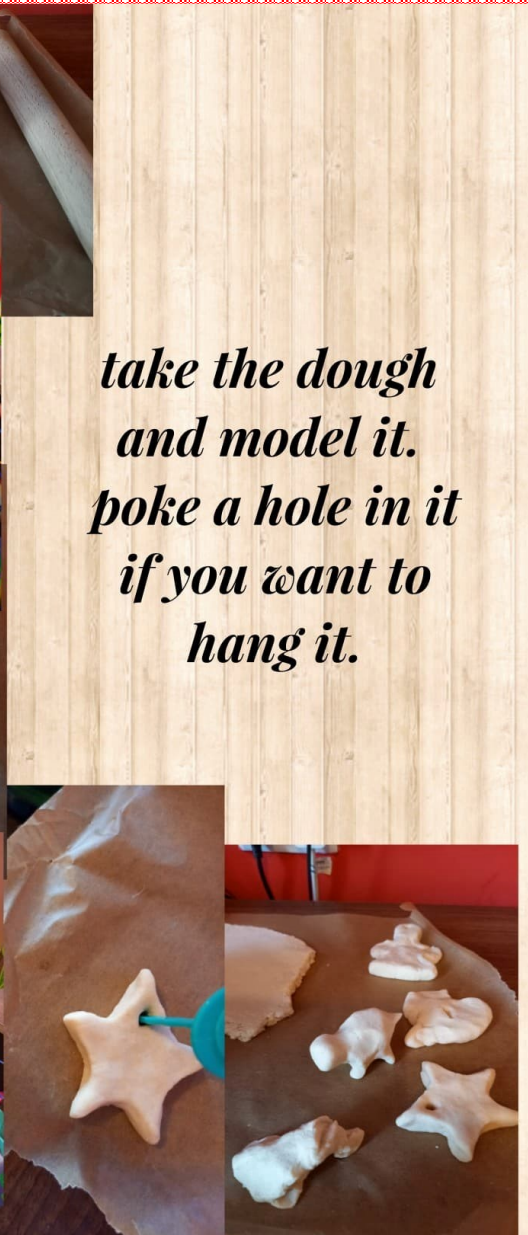
*250g plain flour
