In Acts 14:1-7, Paul and Barnabas preach in the synagogue at Iconium, where many Jews and Gentiles believe their message. However, some unbelieving Jews stir up opposition and hostility, dividing the city. Despite this, the apostles remain for a long time, speaking boldly for the Lord, who confirms their message through signs and wonders. As tensions rise, both Gentiles and Jews, along with their leaders, plot to mistreat and stone them. When Paul and Barnabas learn of this danger, they wisely flee to the nearby regions of Lystra and Derbe. There, instead of giving up, they continue preaching the gospel, demonstrating courage, persistence, and commitment to spreading their message despite persecution.

Acts 14:1-7 In Iconium - 14 At Iconium Paul and Barnabas went as usual into the Jewish synagogue. There they spoke so effectively that a great number of Jews and Greeks believed. ² But the Jews who refused to believe stirred up the other Gentiles and poisoned their minds against the brothers. ³ So Paul and Barnabas spent considerable time there, speaking boldly for the Lord, who confirmed the message of his grace by enabling them to perform signs and wonders. ⁴ The people of the city were divided; some sided with the Jews, others with the apostles. ⁵ There was a plot afoot among both Gentiles and Jews, together with their leaders, to ill-treat them and stone them. ⁶ But they found out about it and fled to the Lycaonian cities of Lystra and Derbe and to the surrounding country, ⁷ where they continued to preach the gospel.



Luke 12:1-12 Warnings and encouragement.

12. Meanwhile, when a crowd of many thousands had gathered, so that they were trampling on one another, Jesus began to speak first to his

disciples, saying: 'Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy. ² There is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden



that will not be made known. ³ What you have said in the dark will be heard in the daylight, and what you have whispered in the ear in the inner rooms will be proclaimed from the roofs. ⁴ 'I tell you, my friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body and after that can do no more. ⁵ But I will show you whom you should fear: fear him who, after your body has been killed, has authority to throw you into hell.
